Subject: Community dialogue of the Judicial Branch with youths from the BGCPR

Greetings. I am writing to summarize what we discussed today. The Office of Education and Community Relations of the Judicial Branch is interested in doing an activity (community dialogue) of around 2.5 hours in duration one afternoon during the week of April 29 – May 3, 2019.

In the activity, we would like a group of 12-15 youths from the Boys and Girls Club of Carolina to participate. In the community dialogue, the youths and staff of the Judicial Branch would participate. The subject of the discussion would be peer conflicts and the ways that these young people could positively address them with the collaboration of the Judicial Branch. The focus of the project would be of an educational nature.

We would like to know if it would be possible to coordinate this activity with you. Depending on what emerges from the discussion, a long-term project might materialize with the children to implement their ideas.

As I may have put forward, there is a non-profit organization of the United States, the National Center for State Courts, which will be doing research on the community activities that courts are doing. In the case of Puerto Rico, they are interested in participating and observing several community dialogues that we are organizing for the week of April 29 – May 3. We will do two dialogues with adult community leaders and two with the youths. We would like for the dialogues with the youths to be with the Boys and Girls Club which you direct.

Looking forward to your confirmation, as soon as possible, that you would like to conduct said activity. If so, we would like to set the date on which it could take place and the point of contact to coordinate it.
